Test Scores Needed for Admission

Submit the results of the TOEFL, IELTS, or other proof of English proficiency exam. The minimum scores are as follows:

- TOEFL: 70 IBT or 525 PBT(School code: 4006)
- IELTS: 6.0 band or higher
- ACT English Sub Score: 21 or higher
- SAT Verbal Score: 510 or higher
- European students may submit CEFR of B2 level or higher •

Courses

The course catalog can be found at <u>http://catalog.nau.edu</u> Full-time students enroll in a minimum of 12 credits each semester. The maximum number of units students can enroll in is 19 per semester. You must take a minimum of 9 in person units before you can take an online class. *All majors are available to exchange students, excluding Dental Hygiene and Nursing.

Language of Instruction

Courses at NAU are conducted in English. For admission, foreign students from countries of citizenship where English is not the official language, must have a score of 525 PBT or 70 IBT on the TOEFL or equivalent.



Accommodation

Late applicants can encounter difficulties in securing adequate on-campus housing, so it is important that students apply for housing between April 15 and May 1 for the fall semester.

Students admitted to NAU prior to April 15th can typically secure on-campus housing.
